Parent Points Program

The main purpose for the Parent Points program is parental involvement. Additionally, operating costs can be kept down if parents have special skills or services to offer for particular services that may be needed.

Each family is required to complete 20 points per year. Each point is equivalent to one hour of volunteer work, or \$10 donation. The deadline to complete points is May 1st. Deficiencies in points that are not completed will be charged to your account at a rate of \$10 per point.

The following are a few examples of ways in which to earn points:

- Become an Officer of (PTLS) Parents and Teachers of Loving Savior: President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, Room Parent Coordinator, Sports Committee, Fundraising, etc.
- Become a Room Parent: 20 points to be divided amongst room parents equally for each class if the parent completes the year as an involved room parent.
- Chaperones for field trips – 1 point per hour attending the field trip
- Drivers for athletic events – 1 point per hour of driving
- Work classroom parties, special holiday events
- Participation in school fundraisers (i.e. tallying money, helping with distribution)
- Donations (such as copier paper, office or classroom supplies, or needed equipment) – 1 point per \$10 donation of goods
- Special services or skills – See the office to see how you can help

Points are negotiable for professional services performed/donations made depending on the donation. Please ask if you have suggestions not listed. It is each family's responsibility to log their points into Gradelink under the Service Hours link on the left side of the parent's account.
