Loving Savior Lutheran School Earthquake/Emergency Kit Information

In order to be prepared in case of an emergency, we are asking for all students to have an emergency kit. You may either purchase these kits from Loving Savior for a cost of \$15.00, or make your own. These emergency kits **MUST** be in your child's classroom by the end of the first week of school. Below is a list of items that should be included in a homemade emergency kit.

It is **suggested** that the following items be sealed in a gallon sized plastic baggie marked with the student's name and grade on it.

- ✓ 2 bottles of water
- ✓ 1 serving of Beef Jerky, a Beef stick, or a can of Vienna Sausages
- ✓ 1 fruit cup or applesauce (with a plastic spoon)
- √ 1 granola bar or energy bar (no peanut products)
- ✓ Note of encouragement to your child

Please include any other items you feel would be important to your child, should it be necessary for them to remain on campus for up to 72 hours. These items will be returned on the last day of school in May.

Or, you may purchase a Professional Emergency Kit which will be on sale for \$15.00 in the office. These kits have a shelf life of 3 years; therefore, you can use these kits for the next several years. These kits include: food, waters, blanket, light sticks, first aid, and a whistle. At the end of the year, we will return the earthquake kit to your child if they will not be returning. For the students that will be returning the following year, we will rotate the kit into the next year's teacher's classroom.
